

## 2021-22 RCCC Registration Information and FAQ

### Who may enroll in the Rapid City Children's Chorus?

Children in grades 4-8 in the Rapid City area are welcome to sign up and sing in the group. Participants should enjoy singing, performing, and meeting other children with the same interests. All are encouraged to sing up and sing!

### Is an audition required?

No auditions are required. Sign up and Sing!

### When and where are rehearsals?

Rapid City Children's Chorus rehearses at the Performing Arts Center, 601 Columbus Street. Rapid City. Once weekly rehearsals will be on Tuesdays from 4:30-5:45 PM. The week of our concert will include one additional Thursday dress rehearsal from 4:30-5:45. Please see our calendar for a complete list of rehearsal dates.

### What is the commitment for the 2021-22 season?

The full season will be divided into two terms this year. Each term includes 11 rehearsals, a final concert, and opportunities to perform in the community. A student may choose to participate in either the Fall or Spring term or choose to participate in both terms.

### How long does the Fall Term last?

The Fall term will run from Tuesday, September 2021 through the Winter Concert on Sunday, December 5, 2021. The Spring term will run from mid-January through May 1, 2022.

### What is the tuition fee per term?

The tuition per term will include four monthly payments of \$45. This can either be paid online at the beginning of each month through PayPal/credit card, or through four automatic payments. Automatic payments will be set up at the beginning of each term with our financial director, Jamie Hower. Term tuition can also be paid in one lump sum of \$180 if preferred. ### What are your Covid protocols?

Rapid City Children's Chorus will follow the guidelines set forth by the Performing Arts Center. These may change as conditions in our community change. Currently, masks for unvaccinated visitors are encouraged but not required. Students will be seated in chairs, spread apart, and a set seating chart will be maintained to better facilitate contact tracing, if needed. A mid-rehearsal break will allow for aerosol dispersal in the room.
